

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE DESTRUCTION, DEFACEMENT OR INJURY TO PROPERTY BELONGING TO OR BEING USED BY THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN, MICHIGAN; TO PREVENT THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF VILLAGE PROPERTY OR EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to destroy, deface, mutilate or in any way injure any property belonging to, or being used by, the Village in or about its streets, alleys, sidewalks, crosswalks, pavements, public grounds, cisterns, walls, pumphouses, or any other village property.

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person, including employees of the Village, to take or put to their own use any Village equipment including ladders, buckets, hose or any apparatus used by the fire department, or any property or equipment used in, or by, any other department of the Village without first having received permission to do so by resolution of the Village Commission.

SECTION 3.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the Allegan County jail for a period of not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances now in effect and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect 20 days after date of passage and approval.
