

ORDINANCE LIMITING PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

ON DESIGNATED STREETS

Effective July 1, 1966

THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN ORDAINS:

section 1. That it shall be unlawful to park any Motor Vehicle, on the following designated portions of streets, at the curbs for a period longer than 90 minutes between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.

- A. The North and South side of Allegan Street West of the Red light for a distance of 300 feet.
- B. The North and South Side of Allegan Street East of the Red light for a distance of 300 feet.
- C. The East and West side of 10th Street North of the Red light for a distance of 300 feet.
- D. The East and West side of 10th Street South of the Red light for a distance of 300 feet.

SECTION 2. The Village of Martin shall erect appropriate signs restricting and limiting parking of Motor vehicles on the streets as herein set forth.

SECTION 3. In addition to any other penalty for violating hereof the Village is authorized to remove any Motor vehicle violating the terms hereof and store such vehicle at the expense of the owner.

SECTION 4. Any person or firm violating any of the restrictions on parking as set forth in this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.00 and costs or by imprisonment in the County jail for a period not exceeding 10 days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance No. 18 shall become effective on the 1st of July 1966.
