

ORDINANCE NO. 29 OF 1978

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE BURNING OF TRASH, GARBAGE AND OTHER MATERIALS IN THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN, MICHIGAN AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, without an authorized permit by the Village Commission, at any time between sunset and sunrise, to make or kindle or cause to be made or kindled or burn any shavings, brush rubbish or other substance outside of a dwelling or building within the Village of Martin.

Section 2. No Person shall at anytime kindle a fire in or upon any paved portion of a street, alley or curb and gutter within the said Village limits.

Section 3. All burning of trash or other waste or rubbish material, whether domestic, commercial or industrial, shall be conducted within a fire-proof masonry or metal burner equipped with an approved spark arrester with openings not larger than three-fourths of one inch in width.

Section 4. Burning of leaves in the open, between sunrise and sunset, when said burning is supervised by a person twelve years of age or older, is permitted.

Section 5. The burning of garbage outside of a dwelling or building is prohibited at any time.

Section 6. "Garbage" means putrescible animal, poultry, fish and vegetable wastes resulting from the slaughter, processing, handling, preparation, cooking or consumption of foods, including animal, poultry and fish carcasses or parts thereof.

Section 7. Any violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and any person, upon conviction thereof in any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100 or by imprisonment at the discretion of such court. Each day that such violations shall occur shall constitute a separate and distinct violation of the provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. All burning of trash or other waste or rubbish material, whether domestic, commercial or industrial, shall be conducted within a fire-proof masonry or metal burner equipped with an approved spark arrester with openings not larger than three-fourths of one inch in width.

Section 4. Burning of leaves in the open, between sunrise and sunset, when said burning is supervised by a person twelve years of age or older, is permitted.

Section 5. The burning of garbage outside of a dwelling or building is prohibited at any time.

# Ordinance No. 29 of 1978

An Ordinance to Regulate the Burning of Trash, Garbage and Other Materials Within the Village of Martin, Michigan, and to Provide Penalties for Violation Thereof.

## The Village of Martin Ordains:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, without an authorized permit by the Village Commission; at any time between sunset and sunrise, to make or kindle or cause to be made or kindled or burn any shavings, brush rubbish or other substance outside of a dwelling or building within the Village of Martin.
