ORDINANCE NO. 48

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Martin under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended).

The Village of Martin ordains:

Sec. 1. Agency Designated. Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Electrical Code, in accordance with Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the Village of Martin is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Village of Martin under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Village of Martin assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.


Sec. 2. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.

Adopted: April 25, 1994.


This Ordinance duly adopted on April 25, 1994 at a special meeting of the Martin Village Council and will become effective immediately upon publication.
